



2026 FASHION ACADEMY FAQ's

Who can attend?

Male, female and non-binary students are accepted into the 2021 Fashion Academy.

Can a recently graduated high school senior attend the Academy?

Yes they can as long as they have just graduated in May or June of 2026.

What if I have attended previously the MMU Fashion Boot Camp but do not yet meet the new grade level requirements of Fashion Academy?

Please contact the Fashion Academy Director at (414) 930-3282 or kuehnlp@mtmary.edu to discuss this special circumstance. While our target audience and format has shifted to students in 8th grade and high school, we appreciate our camp alumni and may be able accommodate you.

How do I select classes I want to attend?

Follow the instructions by filling out the application form or registering via Eventbrite.

Can I set up a payment plan for the Fashion Academy?

Yes – we can work with you to develop a payment plan for the cost of the Fashion Academy (\$350). All registrants are required to submit a \$50 (fifty dollar) deposit to hold their student's place in the Academy. Full tuition must be paid prior to start of classes. To arrange for a payment plan, contact the Fashion Academy Director at kuehnlp@mtmary.edu. All checks should be made payable to Mount Mary University.

Are scholarships available for the Fashion Academy?

Yes – scholarships are available to students. Instructions on how to apply and selection criteria are listed at mtmary.edu/fashionacademy. The deadline to apply for a scholarship is April 30th, 2026. Scholarship awardees will be determined by May 31st, 2026. If you are awarded a scholarship and have previously paid in full you will be refunded the amount of the scholarship that is awarded.

Are lunch or snacks provided at the Fashion Academy?

Yes – students will have one hour for lunch every day that takes place in the university cafeteria. A variety of options will be available. Please note any food allergies or dietary restrictions on the registration form. Advance notice is required to determine if the MMU food service partner can make accommodations for lunch.

Where do I drop off my child on the first day?

A detailed email that includes drop-off instructions will be sent to all students the week before Fashion Academy starts.

Does my child need to provide any supplies for the Fashion Academy?

All supplies will be provided unless otherwise noted for a particular class. Picture This and Strut Your Stuff for the Camera courses do require students to provide their own camera. Smart phone cameras are acceptable.



Who can pick up my child from Fashion Academy?

Any adult picking up a child from Fashion Academy must be provided in advance, including students riding with one another. Anyone picking up a student must show valid ID and be listed as an approved individual at the time of pick up.

What if I need to drop off my child late or pick up my child early?

Mount Mary does not have accommodations to supervise students who arrive early or remain after the 4 p.m. pick-up time. If an emergency arises, please notify the Academy staff (per the Policy Manual). Late pick-up penalties may apply.

Late Drop-Off: Please accompany and wait with your child in the building until Fashion Academy staff is present to check them in.

Early Pick-Up: Please notify the Fashion Academy staff that you are here for an early pick-up, providing your child's name and their Fashion Academy class. Fashion Academy staff will accompany your child and ask you to sign them out. Please have a photo ID ready.

Who should I contact if my child is sick or unable to attend?

Please contact us in advance at (414) 930-3282 so that we can plan accordingly. Please note that no prorated refunds will be given in these instances.
