Note: This is a four-year program in which students complete the pre-requisite courses at Mount Mary University (MMU), the ADN at MORAINE PARK TECHNICAL COLLEGE, and the BSN degree at MMU. Specific admission criteria apply. Some additional pre-requisites may be required depending on student's entry level. For example, CHE 113 is a pre-requisite for BIO 325, and MAT 105 is a pre- or co-requisite for CHE 113. To remain in good standing in the program, a grade of C or better is required for all courses, except those noted below.
