

Starving Artists' Show

General Information

Always the Sunday after Labor Day, the 2021 Starving Artists' Show will be held on September 12 from 10 a.m. to 5 p.m. on the grounds of Mount Mary University. In the case of inclement weather, the show will proceed unless indicated otherwise. There is no rain date.

Application

You can apply by mail or online. Because of the number of applications, we request the following in order to make the jury process as effective as possible:

1. Include representation of the work to be exhibited and (if available) representation of your booth. If you are applying by mail, please send a CD/USB with 5-10 images. If you are applying online, you will be able to upload your images.
2. Fill out both pages of the application and include a description of your work. You will have the option to save the online application if needed.

Application deadline is Monday, March 15, 2021.

Fees

A **\$25** non-refundable jury fee is required with your application. **An application will not be considered without the jury fee.** The jury fee can be paid by check (made payable to the Mount Mary University Alumnae Association) or credit card.

The booth fee will not be collected with your application, only the jury fee. In April, you will receive notification if you are accepted to the show. If accepted, you will be asked to submit payment for the \$125 booth fee.

Artwork

The Starving Artists' Show offers professional and amateur artists the opportunity to sell original art priced at \$100 or less. A wide range of pricing under \$100 is preferred. No separate pricing of pictures and frames will be allowed. Artists selling unlimited edition prints must clearly label them as such. We reserve the right to exclude any items that we consider to be more craft than art. Only works to be sold are to be displayed. We also reserve the right to ask any exhibitor who displays unacceptable items to leave the show. **ALL PROFITS OBTAINED IN THE SALE OF ART BELONG TO THE ARTIST.**

Acceptance

Accepted applicants will be **notified in the middle of April**. In order to balance the show, we accept a limited number of artists in every media. Therefore, previous acceptance into the show does not guarantee acceptance this year!

Booth Area and Set-Up

You will be provided with an artist booth area approximately 16 feet wide. You are responsible for providing your own tent, booth furniture, and all materials needed to display and sell your work. You are wholly responsible for handling all sales transactions. Artists may set up on Saturday, September 11 from 10 a.m.-5 p.m. or on Sunday beginning at 7 a.m. **All artists must check-in between 7-9 a.m. on Sunday morning**
