MOUNT MARY UNIVERSITY PARKING RULES AND REGULATIONS:

Please be aware the Mount Mary University assumes no responsibility for any vehicle or its contents while parked or operated on the University Campus.

Notify the Public Safety Department if your contact or vehicle information changes. (E-mail is recommended: publicsafety@mtmary.edu).
 Display a current permit from your rearview mirror so the number is clearly visible through your windshield.

Students may park only in these student-designated areas:

- Parking lot B (located between 92nd Street and Bergstrom Hall)
- Angled parking along the rear driveway, off 92nd street
- Parking lot C (located between Kostka Hall Theater and Menomonee River Parkway)
- Near Menomonee River Parkway, along driveway where marked with yellow lines.
- Between 5-11 p.m. Mon.-Fri. only: parking lot A (located between 92nd Street and Gerhardinger Center/Dominic Hall)
- Between 5-11 p.m. Mon.-Fri. only : admission's visitors parking in front of Notre Dame Hall

Employee parking areas:

- Parking lot A (located between 92nd Street and Gerhardinger Center/Dominic Hall)
- Parking area behind Haggerty Library
- All parking areas designated as student parking

Guests (of students and employees) should use parking lot B. Overnight parking is allowed in lots B and C only.

Temporary parking in front of Notre Dame Hall is allowed for fast access to childcare (must use hazard lights).

DO NOT park in restricted areas without proper authorization. (Restricted areas are clearly marked with signs and include the following: fire lanes, handicap spaces, the President's parking space, one hour visitor spaces, spaces reserved for auction or contest winners, and spaces reserved for MMU vehicles.)

Vehicles must be parked within the lines of parking spaces. (This is not applicable when snow or ice obscures these lines; however, when lines are not visible, every effort must be made on your part to park reasonably so as to retain maximum parking spaces for all).

In the event of being unable to find a legal parking space, contact Public Safety immediately, and an officer will authorize a solution.

Additional or replacement student permits are available at the MMU Public Safety Office, Rm 79, Bergstrom Hall.

Failure to comply with the above rules and regulations will result in the issuance of a parking citation. The parking citation fine amount is listed on the citation. Fines can be paid in person in the business office, Notre Dame Hall room 159, or via mail. Make checks payable to Mount Mary University.
