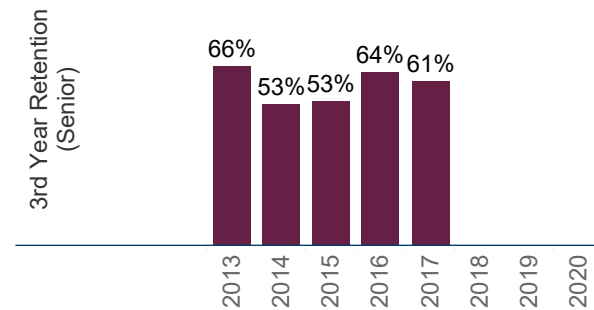
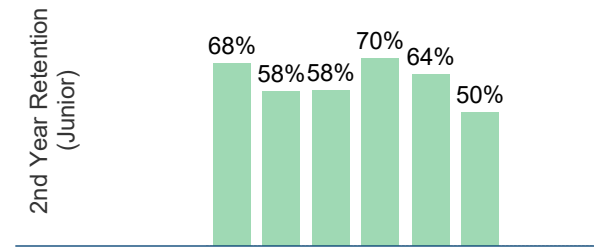
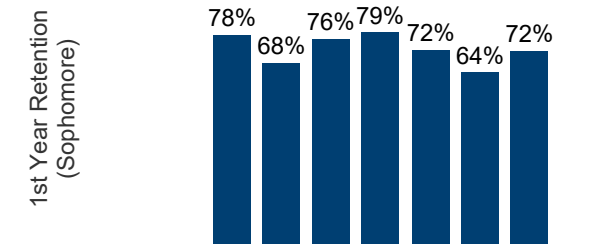

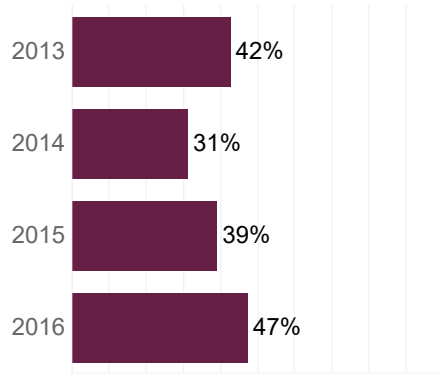

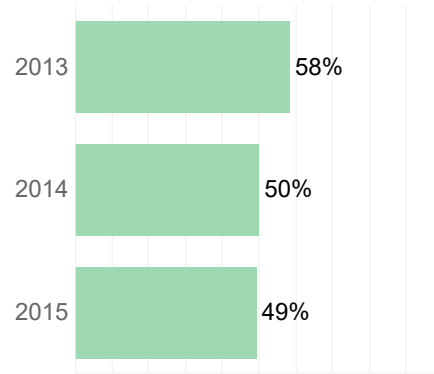

4 Year Graduation Rate by Cohort



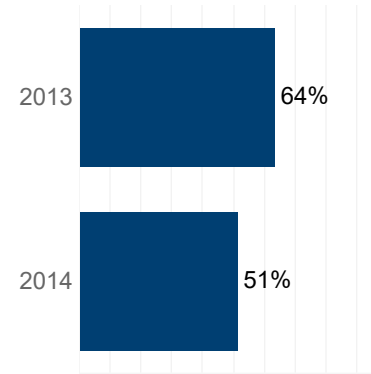
Graduated: 4 Years

Description: This table provides an overview of the number of graduate students enrolled in a given academic year and the percentage of students who return the next year.

Methodology: The number of graduate students (by division) in a given year is tallied. If a student has more than one graduate division, the first one in the academic year is used. Next, enrollment in the next academic year is compared to see if graduate students returned in the next year. If a student graduated, they are excluded.

Note: Graduate Special students are not degree-seeking and may enroll to take a couple courses only. It's not unusual for them to not come back a second year as they are not seeking a formal degree.

Methodology: The number of years is calculated from entry date to graduation.

Note: Entry date for doctoral programs are for student's who have master's degree. The entry date for doctoral program starts when doctoral courses start.
