Program Requirements

There are two options for completing a liberal studies major.

In the first option, the student chooses two distinct liberal arts disciplines; one primary and one secondary, from the following areas of study:

- Art
- Math
- Biology
- Philosophy
- Chemistry
- Psychology
- Communication
 Sociology
- EnglishHistory
- Spanish
 Theology
- In the second option, the student chooses two broad-based liberal arts disciplines; one primary and one secondary, from the following areas of study:

HUMANITIES

Including coursework in communication, English, history, international studies, philosophy, Spanish, and/or theology

SOCIAL SCIENCES

Including coursework in anthropology, economics, justice, political science, and/or sociology

SCIENCES

Including coursework in biology, chemistry, mathematics, physics, and/or psychology

• FINE ARTS

Including coursework in art, dance, and/or music

In either option, the student must complete at least 24 credits in her primary discipline and at least 16 credits in her secondary discipline.
