Undocumented/DACA Students

As one of Wisconsin's most diverse colleges, Mount Mary University embraces, fosters and celebrates the power of diversity and inclusivity. A student's immigration status is not required to be disclosed and does not affect admission decisions.

Students interested in Mount Mary's Nursing program should be aware of the following as they make their enrollment decision:

- Nursing students complete their clinical training through one of our technical college partner institutions.
- Students are subject to background checks when applying for clinical placement and clinical placement decisions are the responsibility of health care agency partners.
- Licensure as a registered nurse in the State of Wisconsin is through the Department of Safety and Professional Services (DSPS) and requires successfully passing the National Council Licensure Examination for Registered Nurses (NCLEX-RN) licensure exam.
 - Individuals are responsible for determining their own eligibility for the NCLEX-RN exam and state licensing
