

## **Over 50 high school students**

from Wisconsin, Illinois, Ohio, and Minnesota participated in the 2021 Summer Leadership Academy. These young women attended the program from June 21-24, 2021 to learn about leadership, college preparation and career exploration. Students gained essential skills that will help strengthen their college applications and valuable knowledge that will follow them into their future careers.



# One Program, Two Formats

To comply with Covid restrictions, the program was held in dual modality format. Forty participants attended the on campus/in-person program and 16 attended the program virtually. Each day of the Academy had a focus:

- College Prep
- Career Exploration
- Personal Leadership
- Leadership in the Community






## A Diverse Group of Participants





# Pre – Academy and Post- Academy Surveys




Summer Leadership Academy participants were asked to complete Pre-Academy and Post-Academy Surveys to measure their understanding of concepts and how they felt they have grown in their understanding of themselves and their preparedness for the world after high school.


## I am prepared for life after high school.

Participants' feelings of preparedness for life after high school improved from 48.6% agreeing or strongly agreeing that they are prepared prior to the academy to 88.2% post-academy.




# I feel like I can make informed decisions about my life after high school.


# **Post Survey Quotes**


## College seems out of reach for me.

Participants' negative feelings about their ability to attend college after high school decreased from 11.9% agreeing college seems out of reach to 0% agreeing college seems out of reach. Participants positive feelings increased from 66.6% disagreeing or strongly disagreeing with that statement to 93% post-academy.




# I am confident in my ability to choose a college that is right for me.

Participants' feelings about their ability to choose a college that is the right fit for them improved from 21.4% strongly agreeing that they are able to do so prior to the academy to 42% post-academy.








# I am confident in my understanding of the factors to consider when choosing a college.






## I know what a FAFSA is.



# I am aware of a variety of sources of funding to help make college affordable.




# **Post Survey Quotes**

Participants' feelings about their knowledge of their personality type and traits improved from 64% agreeing or strongly agreeing that they are aware of these prior to the academy to 93% post-academy.





















# **Post Survey Quotes**



Participants' feelings about their familiarity with strategies for empathetic listening, triggers and effective communication improved from 88% agreeing or strongly agreeing that they understand this prior to the academy to 98% post-academy.






### I understand the definition of vocation.

Participants' feelings about their understanding of the definition of vocation improved from 61.5% agreeing or strongly agreeing with this statement prior to the academy to 86% post-academy.









- "It helped me see the other options and opportunities I was denying myself."

I have a sense of how the words and mantras I hold about myself are linked to my role and resiliency as a leader. Participants' feelings about their understanding of how their self-talk is linked to their resiliency as a leader improved from 9% strongly agreeing that they understand this prior to the academy to 44% post-academy.



# I am aware of healthy ways I can improve my connection with myself and others.

Participants' feelings about their understanding of how they can improve their connection with themselves and others improved from 86% agreeing or strongly agreeing that they understand this prior to the academy to 95% post-academy.








- "I think the academy is a lovely opportunity and I am so glad I participated and got to share thoughts and hear from people just like me, as well as people from very different walks of life."


# I understand what to expect from learning experiences as a college/university student.





## **Fashion Elective:** I understand how to draw inspiration from various sources to create my own original design idea. Participants' feelings about their understanding of creating original designs improved from

59% agreeing or strongly agreeing that they understand this concept prior to the academy to 100% post-academy.










### **Nursing Elective:** I understand the importance of Personal Protective Equipment in healthcare. Participants' feelings about their understanding of the importance of PPE improved


from 83.7% agreeing or strongly agreeing that they understand this concept prior to the academy to 100% post-academy.





# Food Science Elective: I understand the basic chemistry of what makes a foam.



# **Education Elective:** I understand the important thinking skills teachers support in their students.




these concepts prior to the academy to 92% post-academy.







# Yoga Elective: I understand the importance of being present in exercise and in life.

## **Small Groups**

Each Summer Leadership Academy participant had the opportunity to meet with their small groups twice daily. Small groups were lead by a Peer Mentor and an Adult Co-Facilitator. Peer Mentors are young women who have participated in a previous Summer Leadership Academy. Adult Co-Facilitators are Mount Mary students, employees, or community members who support the Peer Mentor in leading the small groups. This year, the Academy had the largest group of "support staff" yet with 9 Peer Mentors and 9 Adult Co-Facilitators.


- "Everyone was very welcoming and kind and I really appreciated how accepting everyone was!"
