In order for Mount Mary University to make a determination that the ESA can be a reasonable accommodation for a student living on campus, the student is required to submit the following documentation. This letter must be on letterhead from a certified and/or licensed physician or mental health provider who is currently providing treatment to the student and who will be providing treatment throughout the academic year. Just like all accommodation services provided by Mount Mary University, students must request this accommodation for each academic year that they are enrolled at Mount Mary.

Documentation must include:

1. That the student has a disability for which the animal is needed.
2. Student is involved in on-going treatment.
3. How the animal assists the student with the disability, including whether the animal has undergone any training.
4. An explanation of the nexus (connection) between student's disability and the assistance that the animal provides.
